
Everest Challenge 2026 - Terms & Conditions

By registering for the Everest Challenge 2026, you agree to the following:

1. Nature of the Event

The Everest Challenge is a physically demanding mountain endurance event taking place on Mount Brandon, Co. Kerry.

Participants acknowledge that:

- This is a long and strenuous hiking challenge
- Mountain terrain and weather conditions can change rapidly
- There are inherent risks involved in participating in mountain activities

Participation is entirely at your own risk.

2. Participant Responsibility

All participants must:

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Have appropriate hiking experience for their chosen team size
- Be physically capable of completing a sustained mountain day
- Carry mandatory kit as outlined by the organisers
- Follow safety instructions given by event staff

Participants are responsible for their own preparation, pacing and decision-making on the mountain.

3. Team Requirements

- Teams must remain together for the duration of the challenge.
- One designated team member must maintain mobile communication as instructed.
- If a team member withdraws, event staff must be notified immediately.

4. Event Modifications & Weather

The organisers reserve the right to:

- Modify the route
- Adjust timings
- Postpone or cancel the event

This may occur due to weather, safety concerns, land access issues, or other unforeseen circumstances.

Safety decisions made by the organisers are final.

5. Withdrawals & Refund Policy

- All entries are non-refundable due to limited capacity and event planning costs.
 - In the event of cancellation by the organisers, options may include postponement or partial refund at the organisers' discretion.

6. Medical & Emergency

Participants confirm that:

- They have disclosed any relevant medical conditions during registration
- They understand that first aid support is available but that this is not a guided expedition

In the event of an emergency, participants agree to follow the instructions of event staff and emergency services.

7. Photography & Media

Photography and video recording will take place during the event.

Participants may appear in promotional materials, including website, social media and print content.

8. Data Protection

Participant data will be used solely for:

- Event administration
- Event related communication
- Processing payments

Marketing communications will only be sent where explicit consent has been given. Data will not be shared with third parties outside of event delivery requirements.
